


Debbie Jeffress' daughter

If you own property in Mexico this can be a disaster for those left behind. **Kris Salgado and Adrian Smith** (Recovering US Lawyer) will be assisting and we will have all the necessary forms available for you to fill out. At time of death you need: Birth Certificate, Marriage Certificate, Copy of your proof

of citizenship or residency, Life insurance policy (if relevant), bank papers and a copy of a notarized Mexican will. You should also have a letter describing what you wish done with your body and personal effects, Burial information and plans (if relevant). US wills are not enforced in Mexico. Your US will is not sufficient for your heirs to take possession of your property. Please, bring copies, not originals, of these documents to the Will Writing Seminar.
